A SKI JUMP NEAR CHICAGO ?!?!?!



Norge Ski Jumping club in Fox River grove is the oldest, continuously open ski club in the United States. As a matter of fact, much of the surrounding land once belonged to the club - that's why you'll find street names like "Ski Hill Road" and "Norge Parkway." Over the years, the club has sold land to pay for updates and improvements to the world-class ski jumping facility. The club was started in 1905 by a group of Norwegian men, most of whom lived in Chicago, but came out to Fox River Grove to ski jump. They soon began holding ski jumping exhibitions. Since then, the club has been an attraction for thousands of people from all over the Midwest who want to enjoy a day of jumping and fun in the sun. Jumping events are held in the winter and summer.

From the 1940's to late 1950's, Norge used to hold jumping events at Soldier Field, covering a custom built,

multi-story scaffolding supported ramp covered with crushed ice. Jumpers would thrill the crowds, speeding down the gigantic jump and flying across the field sometimes even through rings of fire.



One year, Norge even rented out Navy Pier in Chicago and set up a jump where the jumpers landed in Lake Michigan. Yet today, most people have no idea that there's a ski jump only a short drive from Chicago.

Kids of all ages can learn to FLY (Ski Jump) at the Norge state of the art training facility. Norge jumpers and staff continue to win national honors, including a recent sweep at the Junior Nationals.


SAFETY FIRST . . .
