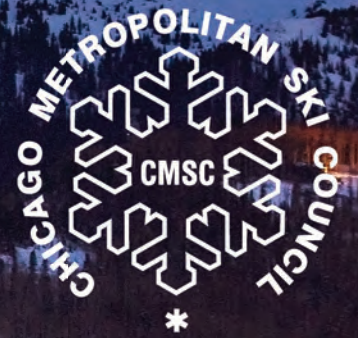

CMSC member clubs have trips planned to almost every major destination in North-America and Europe at various times throughout the year. Please visit their website to learn more about them and their activities.

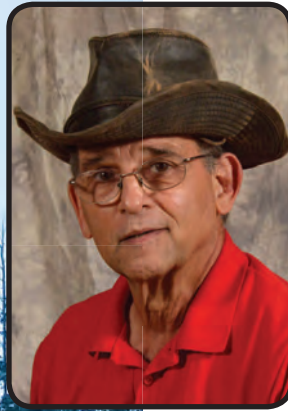

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT



CMSC Clubs Navigating the Slopes & the Situation

So now what?

Today's uncertain times have made it a challenge for trip leaders and decision makers to know exactly how to proceed. Is it prudent to plan and book trips or maybe best to wait and see what happens? Do we concentrate on domestic or foreign ski areas or do we plan activities that preclude skiing and boarding altogether?

The ski areas for the most part seem to be very optimistic. They are continuing to book trips and seem to be moving ahead as usual. Many of CMSC's 66 clubs have already decided to move forward.

CMSC currently has more than 120 trips listed on its web site at skicmsc.com, or in this directory. So with an optimistic view towards the future, if clubs decide to go along with their plans there are a few items to keep in mind.

Most importantly, read the contract carefully. In this environment, trip cancellation clauses are of utmost importance. Reasons for trip cancellation vary and need to be carefully reviewed. On a more positive note, CMSC has and will continue to provide another set of eyes to check club contracts. Our CMSC parliamentarian, Mike McCrery, who is also an attorney, is willing to review CMSC club contracts and make suggestions. He has been of great help in drafting "force majeure" language that should be included in trip contracts to eliminate cancellation penalties.

Also, remember to advise club participants to investigate various types of trip insurance currently available and to choose one that fits their needs. Check out the associate member section at skicmsc.com for more insurance information.

In addition, the number of trip participants needs to be considered in these changing times. Also, room assignments will probably be more of an issue nowadays. If we are not housed slope-side how do we arrange safe transportation to and from the hill while taking social distancing into consideration?

On that note, do we take scheduled airlines to the areas that are quite a distance away or use alternative modes of transportation? Are Midwest ski areas still a possible destination? Can buses still be safe for social distancing?

Club liability issues also need to be addressed with new wording possibly needed on trip waiver and release of liability forms. The individual club should not be held responsible if a participant becomes ill on a trip.

So, I invite you to take a look at the list of club trips at skicmsc.com and sign up now. If you are looking forward to skiing or boarding this season, a club trip may be the answer. They may actually have solved some of the issues that you might be facing with this ongoing and changing situation.

See you on the slopes!

A GREAT VACCINE FOR YOUR WINTER

YOUR 1ST RACE WITH CMSC IS FREE!

You've been cooped up all Spring and Summer, but now it's time to come outside and have some fun and safe social distance competition this Winter. CMSC's racing program will hold 14 races this winter at various Midwest ski areas. Racers progress through five levels of competition from "never raced" to "elite." If you can handle a Blue Square trail in the Midwest, you should do just fine racing with us. We have post-race awards for each class and a season end party to give you a chance to meet other members.

This is a mostly adult league, but kids, young adults and families also race together. Kids under 12 compete for free in our Giant Slalom races. If you are new to racing, your first race entry fee is on us (details on our web site). Helmets are required in all race events. Training clinics are also available to help develop your skills. Many racers also attend weeknight race training at Wilmot with great coaches.

Our races are Giant Slalom (similar to NASTAR) and Slalom (quicker turns). The schedule is to the right, and details are on our website at SkiCMSC-Racing.com. You can sign up for "Race Alerts" on our website or follow our Facebook page (search CMSC Alpine Racing).
