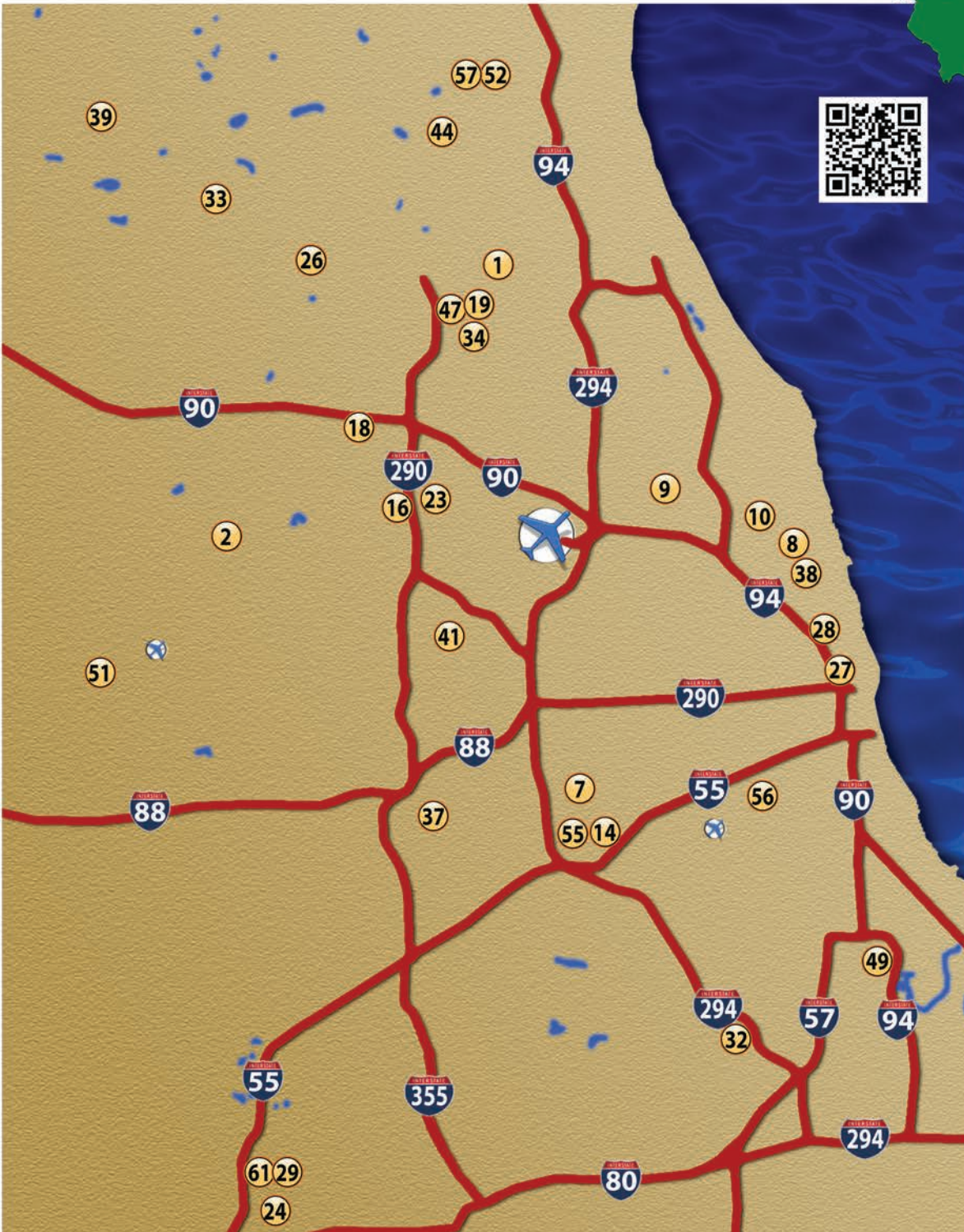

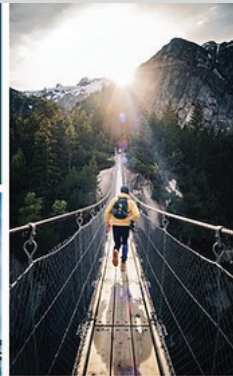

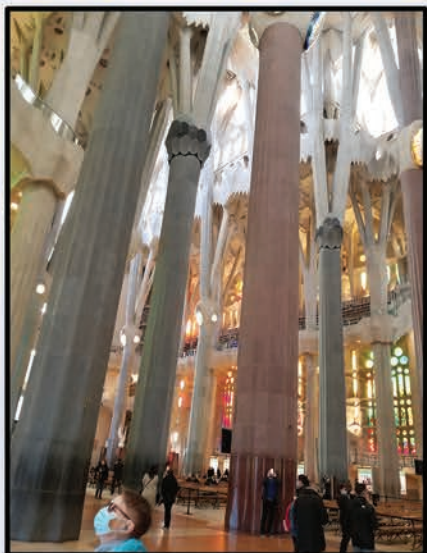
trees that any intermediate skier could handle to glades that are packed like toothpicks. They also offered a good variety of bump runs along with groomed runs.
