Message from the President

Snow, Snow, and more snow??

If you were looking for snow last season out west was the place to be. Mammoth had a record 900+ inches and the Lake Tahoe area had their second snowiest season with some getting over 700".

In Utah, 12 of the 15 Ski Areas set new records. Alta received 903", Park City had 636" and Snowbasin's 613" exceeded the last 2 years combined. This resulted in a total of 44 "Powder Days" which is 12 or more inches in 24 hours. The average is 19 Powder Days!

So much snow comes with both pros and cons. While it makes for great skiing and helps relieve some of the drought conditions in some of these areas, it can also be dangerous. In Big and Little Cottonwood Canyons alone, there were 550 avalanches with 98 crossing roads and 62 of those large enough to bury a car. It also can make travel difficult if not impossible. You can read more about that in the Trip Review for Chicago Week later in the Magazine. One of the bright spots from that trip was seeing how members of different clubs can come together when facing difficult situations.

Let's hope that Mother Nature has another great year of snow for us this season!




